Calvary Chapel Christian School Financial Information

Calvary Chapel Christian School is an outreach of Calvary Chapel of Bangor. It is maintained primarily for the children of its members. However, all children of parents who desire a Christian education for their children are welcome to submit an application.

As many of you know, CCCS goal is to be totally self-supporting, except for the rent-free building and payment of utilities. We hope to pay for all other expenses out of tuition and registration payments.

For those paying tuition monthly please mail or deliver your payment promptly. If you pay in cash, please do so in person and make sure you are issued a receipt at the time of the payment.

Past Due Accounts:

- Tuition is due on the first of each month beginning in July and ending with the last payment in June. Any payments not received by the first of the month will be considered “past due”. You will be expected to contact us if your account becomes past due.

- If your account becomes past due two (2) installments, we will allow you ten working days to clear your account. If it is not cleared, you may be required to withdraw your children from the school.

No registration will be accepted if there is a balance due on an account.

Book and Supply Fees are not refundable after the first week of school.

If your child leaves during the course of the school year, you will be charged for the total of days that your child was enrolled.

To be eligible for the Calvary Chapel rate, you must regularly attend and support Calvary Chapel for a minimum of one school year.

History

Calvary Chapel Christian School (CCCS) was founded in 2002 by Calvary Chapel Bangor under the pastoral leadership of Ken Graves. Ken Graves is the founding pastor of Calvary Chapel Bangor, which began in 1991 in his Bangor apartment. They started with a core of about twelve people that were meeting for Bible study, prayer and fellowship. Calvary Chapel has grown to more than 1,000 members that regularly attend. We began Calvary Chapel Christian School as part of what God has given us the vision to do. The school was accredited through Calvary Chapel Education Association (CCEA) and the Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS) in 2009. We have seen God do great things in the lives of many people. We are excited about the future and the opportunity before us.

School Philosophy

In agreement with the statement of Fundamental Truths as found in the book Calvary Chapel Distinctives the School Philosophy is as follows:

Education is "For the equipping of the saints, for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of faith and the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head-Christ-from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love." (Ephesians 4:12-16)

In partnership with the students' parents, CCCS seeks to provide an excellent academic foundation. All subject matter must be subject under the ultimate purpose of knowing and serving Jesus Christ. We must endeavor to discover the gifts the Lord has given to each of us, then to develop them for the work before each of us. We are told to speak the truth. We must learn the truth to speak it. We are told to speak the truth in love. We must know the truth personally to speak it in love. Christ is the Word. (John 1:1) He is truth. All true learning and education begins and ends with Christ. Therefore, CCCS gives honor to the Word of God in all that we do.

Mission Statement

CCCS is dedicated to the spiritual, academic, physical and social development of the students it serves. The school aims to create a learning environment that is challenging, supportive and dedicated to foster holistic (Heart, Soul, and Mind - Matthew 22:37) growth within each individual. In all its academic endeavors, CCCS seeks to discover and encourage the gifts each student possesses; to deepen the students understanding of the Christian faith and relationship with Jesus Christ; and inspire the students to realize his or her full potential in serving the Lord to the betterment of our community and the world.

Statement of Faith

The Calvary Chapel Church has been formed as a fellowship of believers in the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Our supreme desire is to know Christ and be conformed to His image by the power of the Holy Spirit. We are not a denominational church, nor are we opposed to denominations as such, only to their over-emphasis of the doctrinal differences that have led to the division of the Body of Christ.

We believe the only true basis of Christian fellowship is Christ's (Agape) love, which is greater than any differences we possess, and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.

We believe worship of God should be spiritual. Therefore, we remain flexible and yielded to the leading of the Holy Spirit to direct our worship.

We believe worship of God should be inspirational. Therefore, we give great place to music in our worship.

We believe worship of God should be intelligent. Therefore, our services are designed with great emphasis upon the teaching of the Word of God that He might instruct us how He should be worshipped.

We believe worship of God should be fruitful. Therefore, we look for His love in our lives as the supreme manifestation that we have been truly worshipping Him.

We believe in all the fundamental doctrines of orthodox evangelical Christianity.

We believe in the inerrancy of Scripture, that the Bible, Old and New Testaments, is the inspired, infallible Word of God.

We believe that God is eternally existent in three separate persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We believe that God the Father is the personal, transcendent, and sovereign Creator of all things.

We believe that Jesus Christ is fully God and fully human, that He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, provided for the atonement of our sins by His vicarious death on the Cross, was bodily resurrected by the power of the Holy Spirit, ascended back to the right hand of God the Father, and ever lives to make intercession for us.

After Jesus ascended to Heaven, He poured out his Holy Spirit on the believers in Jerusalem, enabling them to fulfill His command to preach the Gospel to the entire world, an obligation shared by all believers today.

We believe that all people are by nature separated from God and responsible for their own sin, but that salvation, redemption, and forgiveness are freely offered to all by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. When a person repents of sin and accepts Jesus Christ as personal Savior and Lord, trusting Him to save, that person is immediately born again

and sealed by the Holy Spirit, all his/her sins are forgiven, and that person becomes a child of God, destined to spend eternity with the Lord.

We believe that all the gifts of the Holy Spirit mentioned in Scripture are in practice today, the greatest gift of all being Christ's love.

We believe that church government should be simplistic rather than a complex bureaucracy and we depend on the Holy Spirit to lead rather than on fleshly promotion.

We await the pre-tribulation rapture of the church, and we believe that the second coming of Christ with His saints to rule on the earth will be personal, pre-millennial, and visible. This motivates us to holy living, heartfelt worship, committed service, diligent study of God's Word, regular fellowship and participation in adult baptism by immersion and Holy Communion.

We seek to teach the Word of God in such a way that its message can be applied to an individual's life, leading that person to greater maturity in Christ.

We do not believe in "positive confession" (the faith movement belief that God can be commanded to heal or work miracles according to man's will); human prophecy that supercedes the Scriptures; the incorporation of humanistic and secular psychology into Biblical teaching; the over-emphasis of spiritual gifts and experiential signs and wonders to the exclusion of Biblical teaching; or that true Christians can be demon-possessed

We are neither Five Point Calvinists nor are we Armenians. We adhere firmly to the Biblical teaching of God's sovereignty and man's responsibility. We avoid any theological systems of belief which go beyond the written Word and thereby divide the body of Christ.

In our services we focus on a personal relationship with God through worship, prayer, and the teaching of the Word of God. We teach both expository and topically. We do not allow speaking in tongues loudly during services, nor prophecy while a Bible study is in progress, because we do not believe the Holy Spirit would interrupt Himself. We have specific "after-glow services" and believers' meetings when these gifts of the Spirit may be exercised.

Staff

The teachers and staff at CCCS were hired primarily because they have a saving knowledge of Jesus, and HE is Lord of their lives. In addition, they have a willingness to do whatever it takes to provide quality education for our students. Certification is an important consideration in selecting our teachers. Under the terms of our accreditation, 90 percent of our staff must hold a Bachelor's Degree or higher.

What makes us different

There are many things that set us apart from other schools: 1) CCCS is the Lord's school where the staff lives the Christian life view they teach. 2) The academic program strongly emphasizes skills-the building of a strong foundation of facts, and the teaching of thinking skills (logic, memory strategies, study habits) 3) Teachers focus on learning styles and attempt to meet individual needs.

Curriculum

Bible lessons, our curriculum & text are the Bible. We write our own lessons. Our subjects, we use some textbooks that are published by Christian companies, and some are published by secular companies.
